9.	AGE OF MOTHER:	40 years



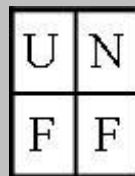

These trucks come every day. He goes there very early to make sure he catches them. From these he comes home with Bread, chicken insides and drinks. When he comes home with these items they all join in and eat. Unfortunately the family sometimes depends on this food. The older boys/men at the dampsite tend to harass the smaller ones and even snatch items from them.</i>

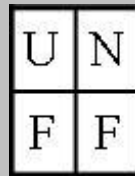
